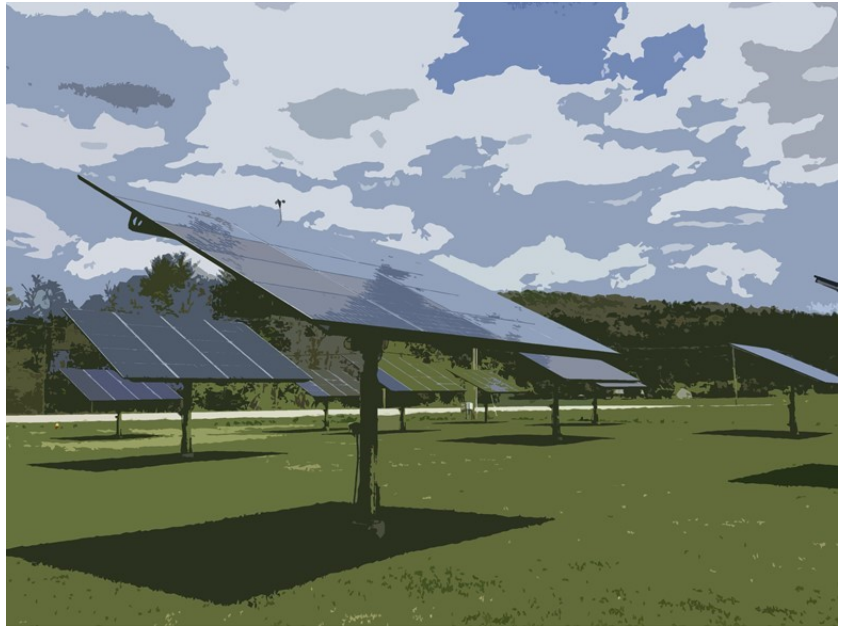


# Private Non-profit Collaboration for Affordable Solar
